# **Delivering change**

- Right clinician, right diagnostic in the right place at the right time
- Virtual Ward and Technology Enabled Care (TEC) support community management
- 740 referrals triaged by specialist paramedics in the ambulance hub
- Multi-professional workforce to meet complex, changing needs of patients
- 461 ambulance dispatches avoided, 366 fewer people taken to the Emergency Department
- Better outcomes and healthcare savings

Specialist Paramedics triaged 740 Cat 3 and 4 calls



5 This prevented 461 ambulances from being dispatched

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Community Rapid Response dispatched to 37 urgent referrals from Specialist Paramedics 740 461 37

More than £130k saved and ambulances and crews freed up to respond to other calls
